Symptomatic Cases

- Learners 5-11 need to book a PCR, isolate until results received – if positive, they isolate for 7 days.
- Learners 11+ and vaccinated adults need to book a PCR, isolate until results received - if positive, they isolate for 7 days.
- All positive cases must isolate for at least 7 days pending the outcome of a negative LFT on day 6 and 7 – 24hrs apart. They can leave isolation from day 8. (Unvaccinated adults isolate for 10 days). If any of the LFT on day 6 & 7 are positive, they need to isolate until the 10th day. (see chart below for more details)
- Unvaccinated adults need to book a PCR, isolate until results received – if positive, they isolate for **10 days**.

When to test

- If you have **symptoms** at any time, you must take a PCR test.
- If you have **no symptoms** you can take a **LFT**.
- If a learner or staff member has had a positive lateral flow test, they should report the result to NHS/School, self-isolate and follow self-isolation guidance. **There is no longer the need to book a follow up PCR test following a positive LFT unless you start to have symptoms.**
- Symptoms = Book PCR
- Routine LFT testing/Close contact = Take LFT
- Positive LFT, no symptoms = Do not need to book PCR, follow isolation rules.
- Positive LFT and then you get symptoms = Book PCR and follow isolation rules.

Under 5's

- Learners under 5 not required to isolate or take a test (PCR or LFT) unless directed by the GP/TTP or a parent's preference.
- If they have symptoms; they need to stay at home until they are better and have no symptoms.
- If they have been a close contact of a positive case they do not need to isolate.

Close Contact

- Close contact = in the household, in school (informed through a warn and inform letter), within the community, out of school activities or informed by TTP directly, notified through the App or informed directly from the person who is positive.
- Learners 5-11 should use LFT's daily for at least 7 days and action appropriately
- Siblings of a positive case do not need to isolate but they must take daily LFT's for 7 days. The LFT's must be taken before they come to school each day. If at any point they develop symptoms they must book a PCR and isolate for 7 days. (Whilst waiting for the results of the PCR other siblings in the family do not need to isolate.)
- Learners 11+ and vaccinated adults should use LFT's daily for at least 7 days and action appropriately
- If one of the LFT are positive, you must isolate and your 7 day isolation starts from this point (TTP will confirm this with you)
- Unvaccinated adults must self-isolate for 10 days. Should also take a LFT test on day 2 and day 8
