Dear Parents,

As you are all aware the school will be closing at the end of the school day tomorrow Friday 20th March. We are currently uncertain for how long the closure will be. It is going to be a challenging time for us all.

The home learning packs have been sent home today and we are hoping all packs to those who are currently isolating will have been delivered before the end of tomorrow. Pupils log in details for Hwb, RM Easimaths, TT Rocks and Study Ladder (KS2) are in their packs. Additional suggestions of tasks to do at home have been placed on our Facebook page.

Although we have sent work home, what our children need right now is to be comforted and loved and to feel like it's all going to be ok. Don't worry about them regressing in school, everyone is in the same situation and when we return to school we will ensure they receive the support they need. Teachers are experts at this! Try not to stress over the work, don't fall out with them if they won't do the learning tasks you want them to do. Their mental health will be more important than their academic skills, how they felt during this time will stay with them long after the memory of what they did during this school closure.

The local authority are currently looking at ways to provide childcare for key workers. The key worker list includes NHS, Armed Forces, Teachers, Care home workers, social workers, police officers, Prison officers, Firefighters, Environmental health officers, Highway agency traffic officers & Local authority planners.. When we have more information regarding this we will let you know.

We will continue to communicate with you either through text messages, our Facebook page or through your child's Hwb emails from their class teachers.

Please keep yourselves safe and look after one another. Hopefully we will be back to normal as soon as possible.
