FEELING UNWELL

If your child has a runny nose, sore throat without a fever or a mild cold they can still attend school as normal.

If they have any of the Covid-19 symptoms:

- A high temperature: this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- A new, continuous cough: this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste: this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

They must **not** attend school. They will need to self-isolate for 10 days and you will need to arrange a test. Please inform school immediately of the test results. If the test is negative they can return to school, if it is positive please follow all advice given.
