SECONDARY ADMISSION

Parents of year 6 pupils can now apply for secondary September 2021 admissions through Denbighshire County Council website and complete the online form. **The closing date is 6th November 2020.**

NURSERY AND RECEPTION ADMISSION

Parents of current nursery pupils can apply for the reception class September 2021 (full time education) from 28th September through Denbighshire County Council website and complete the online form. **The closing date is 20th November 2020.**

Admission for September 2021 nursery class will open from 29th September through Denbighshire County Council website and complete the online form. **The closing date is 19th February 2021.**

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please remember to mark all your children's uniform with their names including their coats, water bottles and bags.

Additional uniform can be ordered online at www.workplace-worksafe.co.uk and will be delivered to your home.

Some of you may find the website 4directuniforms.co.uk of use, they have school trousers with more room around the waist/hips with shorter leg lengths!

WATER BOTTLES

Please remember to send your child to school with their filled water bottle with water only. (They can have a juice carton only with their packed lunch). They need to take the water bottles home every day and wash them. Additional water bottle can be bought from school and we will put the £1.50 payment on your parent pay account.

FEELING UNWELL

If your child has a runny nose, sore throat without a fever or a mild cold they can still attend school as normal.

If they have any of the Covid-19 symptoms:

- A high temperature: this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- A new, continuous cough: this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste: this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

They must **not** attend school. They will need to self-isolate for 10 days and you will need to arrange a test. Please inform school immediately of the test results. If the test is negative they can return to school, if it is positive please follow all advice given.
