## **SCHOOL ESSENTIALS GRANT**

Parents who receive a qualifying benefit can get a grant of £125 if their children are in reception, year 1 to 11. (Year 7 are entitled to a grant of £200). If you receive one of the following benefits you would be entitled to apply: income support, income-based job seekers allowance, income related employment and support allowance, child tax credit with an annual income below £16,190, pension credit, support under part 6 of the immigration and asylum act and universal credit with a yearly net evening of no more than £7,400. If you receive working tax credit you cannot apply. You can apply through Denbighshire County Councils' website and the closing date for the 2024/2025 school year is 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025. A looked after child can apply without a parent, guardian or carer receiving a qualifying benefit.
