## **COVID TESTING**

If they have any of the Covid-19 symptoms: A high temperature (this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back), a new, continuous cough (this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours) or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste (this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal). You must **not** attend school, the whole household needs to isolate and you must arrange a test. **If you are isolating this means you cannot leave your house to play/exercise (other than in your garden), shop, visit other households or meet with friends.** You can apply for an appointment at a drive in or order a home kit online – [gov.wales/apply-coronavirus-test](https://gov.wales/apply-coronavirus-test) (you may need to keep refreshing the site to get a test centre near you) or phone 119. If you have difficulty getting a test please contact the school and we will do our best to assist.
