## **BONFIRE NIGHT**

The following is a message we have received from the police and we have been asked to share:

- There will be no organised public bonfires or firework displays this year.
- No visitors are allowed into your garden. If a firework display in your garden turns into a party at your house, you are putting everyone at risk of catching covid and you may be breaking the law.

Please keep yourself and your family safe and prevent adding pressure to the emergency services during already busy times. Thank you.

## **COVID TESTING**

If they have any of the Covid-19 symptoms: A high temperature (this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back), a new, continuous cough (this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours) or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste (this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal). You must **not** attend school, the whole household needs to isolate and you must arrange a test. **If you are isolating this means you cannot leave your house to play/exercise (other than in your garden), shop, visit other households or meet with friends.** You can apply for an appointment at a drive in or order a home kit online – [gov.wales/apply-coronavirus-test](https://gov.wales/apply-coronavirus-test) (you may need to keep refreshing the site to get a test centre near you) or phone 119. If you have difficulty getting a test please contact the school and we will do our best to assist.
