Hello, we are all looking forward to welcoming you back at school from next week, but no doubt things will look and be a little different here for a while.

We've put this pack together to explain to you some of the new rules. Do you know why we are having new rules at school? Yes, that's right it's because of coronavirus (covid 19). This means we have to work extra hard to keep ourselves and everyone else healthy and as safe as we can. If you follow these rules it will help, make sure we can't spread the coronavirus at school.

We know things will be tough, they will be strange, you might not get to see all your friends and do all the things you used to do in school but it's really important that we see you back here and use this time to see how things are, school might be like this for a while!



Arriving at school

- You will wait outside the pedestrian gate with your parent. Everyone will need to follow the 2m social distancing rule
- Auntie Nicola will be waiting for you with a smile as they open the gate.
- One family at a time will enter through the gate. You will say goodbye to Mum or Dad and then you will walk on to the yard following the yellow footsteps, you will see your teacher waiting for you by your class door with a big smile.



- Wash your hands at your allocated sink straight away.
- Then go straight to sit at your allocated desk. (This will be your spot for the day, and it will have all your things ready for you)
- Stay in your classroom.
- Stay at least 2m away from other pupils and staff. For example, if someone is at the sink give them space, wait your turn. There are stickers and tape on the floor to help you make sure you are 2m away from anyone else.

Break Times

- You will need to wash your hands in your designated sink before and after eating your fruit snack you have brought from home if you have one.
- Exit class through your designated doors to the playground.
- At playtimes the infants will be on the back yard and the juniors on the front.
- Stay 2m away from your classmate. Your teachers have sorted some play equipment for you to use.
- Only one in the toilet at a time.
- Wash your hands at the end of playtime before you go back into class.
- Wet play times: stay in class and sit at your table.



Lunchtimes

- You will order your packed lunch in the morning; you will be told the choice of fillings on the day.
- Wash your hands before eating.
- You will sit at your table in class to eat.
- Your table will be wiped clean before and after eating by your teacher.
- Dispose of rubbish in the bin provided.
- Wash your hands after eating.
- Don't share food.
- Use your own water bottles for drinking. (Filled from home)



Toilet

- Use the toilet allocated to your class only. (The infants will use the toilet nearest their class and the juniors will use the toilet near ystafell llas. In each toilet there is a designated girl and boys' cubicle.)
- Only one child in the toilets at any one time.
- Wash your hands at the sinks.



Washing hands

- Wash your hands with soap and hot water for at least 20 seconds. (Remember you can sing Happy Birthday twice)
- Dry your hands thoroughly.
- Wash your hands regularly through the day – arriving at school, before and after eating, after play time, if you cough or sneeze, if you used a laptop or chrome book.
- Allow for 2m distance at sinks, this may mean waiting your turn.
- Sometimes you will use hand gel, this can be found around the school, but you will also have your own individual bottle of hand gel just for you to use in your tray.



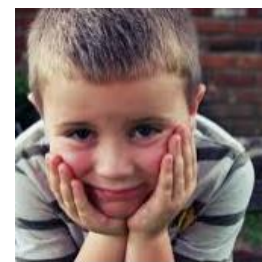
Illness

- If you are feeling unwell let the class teacher know as soon as possible.
- Remember to cough/sneeze into your arm or use the tissues provided.
- Wash your hands after coughing/sneezing.



Concerns and problems

- If you have any concerns or are worried, then speak to your teacher.
- We are here as always, to help and support you.



The Class



- Use the equipment in your pack/tray only – only you will use this equipment.
- Please do not share your equipment with anyone else.
- Please do not use any other equipment in the class without getting permission.
- If you need anything ask your teacher first.
- Stay at your table to do your work unless you are told otherwise
- Keep 2m away from other children in the class.
- Bring your own drink in a filled water bottle to have at your desk throughout the day.
- You have your own tissues and hand gel in your pack.
- You will have a mixture of lessons in your class and outdoor.
- The class door and windows will be open.

Home time

- Your teacher will lead you back to the yard.
- Keep 2m away from your friends when walking and waiting.
- You will be sent to your parents one by one.
- You will need to go home straight away and change your clothes so your parents can put them straight in to the wash. (Year 6 only you will need to wear clean clothes every day you are in, just like the teachers)
- You cannot wait outside the school gates for your friends.

WHAT YOU NEED EACH DAY:

- Wear your own clothes – suitable for being outdoors. You can wear trainers.
- Bring a filled water bottle.
- Hat and sunscreen for sunny weather.
- A coat if it is raining.

*Remember you can still talk, play and have fun
with your friends despite being 2 meters apart!*
