Everyone has an individual **LEGAL DUTY** to refer child protection concerns to the designated safeguarding leads.

If you are the one chosen to make a disclosure to:

- Make time, listen and accept what they say try not to appear shocked or disbelieving, even if you feel like it. The disclosure should not need to be repeated to avoid further distress.
- Don't offer an opinion or dismiss what they are saying.
- Do not collude or promise confidentiality.
- Do not investigate or ask any leading questions record the disclosure in their own words including dates/times/places – who, when, where?
- Explain your responsibility and pass it on personally to the designated safeguarding leads.
- The disclosure should be recorded on the 'Safeguard my school' online system as soon as possible.
- Remember if a child is in need of care and support, pass it on today to the designated officers.
