SECONDARY ADMISSION

Parents of year 6 pupils can now apply for secondary September 2026 admissions through Denbighshire County Council website. **The closing date is 3rd November 2025.**

NURSERY & RECEPTION ADMISSION

Nursery and Reception applications for September 2026 admissions open from this **Monday 22nd September** through Denbighshire County Council website.

The closing date for Reception applications is 17th November 2025 – **those who have children in our current nursery class will need to apply now for Reception.**

The closing date for Nursery applications is 16th February 2025.

3-YEAR-OLD FUNDING

If your child’s 3rd birthday falls between September 1st 2025 and December 31st 2025, they are eligible for funding to attend the rising 3’s at our school for the Spring and Summer term, 8.55-10.55am Mon-Fri.
